



Xhesika Cerri

Fam 14 years old and I am in the ninth class. I study in the "Rahma School". I have been too young when my father passed away and my family was not prepared for this, he left us in a very bad economic situation. My mum was not employed and **our only support was Rahma Mercy**.

"Your association has changed our lives. No one never helped us and sometimes our house was empty, I mean there was nothing to eat. When Rahma Mercy started helping us, everything changed.

When we registered as orphans, we also started to attend Islamic courses. There I learnt about my Lord; my life took a different path. I felt like my God closed a door for me but He opened another one even bigger. Your help and support were endless.

I was only 10 years old, and my brother was 14 when we found out that we would move to another school, to "Rahma School", a school with very high standards and with conditions which no school has in Albania. I still study in this school together with my brother, it seems like nothing has happened, we have no problems, we are even better than before.

I cannot find words to describe my gratitude which comes from the deep of my heart, I thank you for changing my life. May the Almighty reward you and your families with Jannah! Aameen."

Due to the Pound and Euro exchange rate we have had to increase the price of sponsoring an orphan. It NOW costs £25 a Month (£300 a year) to sponsor an Orphan. All anonymous donors are requested to update their standing orders to reflect the new price. 

Emdee Education Centre

With the help of Emdee Charitable Trust, we are building a purpose built Madrasah in a densely populated area of Elbasan. Currently we have 5 Madrasahs in the locality with students really cramped up in small flats. This project will allow all the Madrasahs currently in flats to be relocated to the Emdee Education Centre.

5 floors, Male and Female Musalla, 8 Classrooms, Accommodation and Kitchen for Da'wah workers, Wudhu and Bathroom facilities.

IMAM COURSE & JALSA

IMAM COURSE PROGRAMME

Our Imam Course has been really successful. For many years the biggest dilemma Rahma had to face when trying to open a Madrasah in an area where Islam was weak was to find a suitable teacher. We have targeted 12 students from such areas and brought them into our boarding facility with the hope that upon graduation they can go back and serve their respective communities.

Our first student (Imam Lulzim) graduated and was appointed as an Imam and a teacher in a village called Lamolla and is serving the community there.





JALSA

Throughout the year we have various Jalsas (Presentation Ceremonies) where students perform and showcase what they have learnt in Madrassah in front of ulama, international guests, parents and the local community.

RAHMA ACADEMY

The Rahma Academy is Rahma's land mark project established in 2013.

Currently housing the Rahma School and a variety of our important projects.

It has been 5 years since the opening of the Academy and year on year the activity within it has also been increasing. The IT, English, Islamic studies courses and Girl's hifz class are amongst the general activity that take place. In addition to this, the lower floor shop spaces have been rented to help self-sustain the building. The top floor accommodation is catering for our field team staff member who has moved over to Albania from the UK.

The 6th floor in the Academy is the administration floor for all the Rahma Projects. The conference room is used for various staff meetings. The multi-purpose theatre is used very frequently for assemblies, seminars, training and presentations.

I am from Albania and my history started in 2006 when I learned everything about my creator and the Quran in their Madrasah, Madrasah Teqe. I didn't know that dreams can come true, but I achieved many things, thanks to them, that no one expected.

In 2013 they built a huge school in my city. This was called the Rahma Academy and it was my High School. I started studying there 4 years ago and I was just a student who was searching for knowledge and nothing else but they gave me more than this.

If Rahma wouldn't exist I wouldn't be able to know my creator, I wouldn't be able to study hard like I have done, I wouldn't be able to be where I am today, studying nursing in one of the best university in Albania and I wouldn't be able to be a good Muslim example for others. I thank the Almighty a lot that I will be one of the first women with hijab working as a nurse in my country. But I thank Him more for bringing Rahma Mercy as a reason for me to know about Islam.

They have been my best support in my journey and I really thank them for everything they have done. I'm praying and I will pray to my creator to reward Rahma people with Janatul Firdaws.

It costs £500 to sponsor a child for a full academic year at the Rahma School, this cost covers first class private education with state of the art facilities and includes transport to and from the school.

RAHMA INSTITUTE RAHMA'S NEW PROJECT

The Rahma Institute is by far our biggest project to date. The aim of this project is to further our work in the educational sector.



The intention of this facility is to:

- Have a female boarding facility for advanced Islamic education.
- Relocate the Rahma School currently at the Rahma Academy in to this Institute. This will free up the current Rahma Academy so it can be used as a boarding facility for boys with higher Islamic education. It will also be used for college education.
- Give access to prayer facilities for men, women and children.
- Provide a health clinic.
- Have a retail block for income generation.
- Comprise of outdoor and indoor sports and recreational facilities.


