Orphan Project

When the father of a child passes away, they not only lose a leading figure but they also lose the love, guidance, lessons, and security a father brings to a child's life. At Rahma, we strive to support these orphans, with the help of our sponsors, to give aid in various forms. This could be financial aid, food parcels, blankets, clothing, etc.

When an orphan sees the love and generosity of others helping them with their day-to-day requirements, it brings a sense of comfort to their heart knowing there are people out there willing to help them purely for the sake of The Almighty, despite never meeting them. The orphans always say to us how much they pray for the sponsors and by having your support they do not feel like they are missing out compared to their friends who still have their fathers.

The rewards for someone who helps an orphan can only be given by The Almighty, this same action is also a great means of Sadaqah.

The beloved Prophet (PBUH) told us,

'Give charity without delay, for it stands in the way of calamity' — Tirmidhi.

Sponsoring an orphan costs £25 per month (£300 per year)

Every sponsor will receive a profile introducing them to the orphan and at the end of each year, they will receive a report with updates about how the orphan has been doing.

When Rahma first started working in the Balkans, it was clear that one area we had to focus on, was reviving Islam back into the lives of locals. This project was set up to ensure the future generations had an opportunity to regain their Islamic identity not only by their name, but by the way they present themselves.

In the UK, our children are sent to study in Madrasa for two hours every day during the week. From the age of five, they are taught different aspects of Islam and are guided on putting the knowledge into practice in their daily schedule. Every week, at least 10 hours are spent learning about the fundamentals of our beautiful religion. Unfortunately, this is not the same for our children in the Balkans who only receive four hours of education on a weekly basis.

To support a Madrasa, it costs £210 per month

To sponsor a student, it costs £12.50 per month







Imam & Muallimah Course

'Give a man a fish, he will eat for a day. Teach a man how to fish, he will eat forever.'

This famous quote perfectly describes the aim of this project. We are not only teaching young boys and girls the fundamentals of Islam; we are providing them with the tools they need to go spread the knowledge across the Balkans. The students that graduate are open to many opportunities, whether they choose to stay in Albania or move away to further their studies. In 2020, we set up the Muallimah course in order to have our own teachers to prepare for when we open the Rahma Institute.

The cost to sponsor an Imam Or Muallimah is £100 per month.

Each sponsorship will consist of the accommodation, food, education, books and transport.




Imam Testimonial








From the time we opened our very first Madrasa, over 20 years ago, we have been providing all our students with free books when they enrol in our Madrasas. This is to ensure that we are fulfilling our duty of furthering the message of Islam to our brothers and sisters in the Balkans. We also provide Qur'ans that have been translated into the Albanian language to the wider communities.

Each set costs only £20 This consists of 8-syllabus books, 1 Arabic

Water Well

Water is fundamental to life, yet even today millions of people, already struggling against poverty, lack access to clean and safe water sources. We empower communities by giving them the means to improve the quality of their lives as well as their social and economic prospects. We can only do that with the help of our donors. Reliable access to safe, clean water means that drinking, cooking, washing, watering crops and animals and purifying oneself no longer pose a risk of illness. Clean and safe water improves health. It provides security and stability

which enables beneficiaries to pursue their livelihood. For a donor who provides clean water, there are the rewards of ongoing blessings for themselves and their loved ones.

Sa'd ibn Ubadah asked The Prophet (PBUH), "Umm Sa'd has died; what form of Sadaqah is best?" He replied: "Water (is best)." He dug a well and said: "It is for Umm Sa'd." – Sunan Abi Dawud

Providing water in this way is a very good way of offering a Sadaqah Jaariyah (continuous charity) as you can expect to reap The Almighty's blessing for as long as the well supplies water. To date we have built 205 water wells across Kosovo and Albania. With your support, we can continue to provide access across the Balkans.

It costs £1,300 to build a well.

Total Income | Year Ending March 2020


